



NON-MEMBER APPLICATION

The Non-Member Pass is available to any competitor who would like to compete in a climbing competition but is not ready to commit to the whole season. A competitor may pay the Non-Member fee (\$5.00) on the day of the competition and compete in the sanctioned event. The Non-Member Pass is for the single competition for which it is paid. There is no limit to the number of Non-Member Passes a person may purchase in a season.

Please note that competitors who use only the Non-Member pass are not eligible to advance to Regional, Divisional or National Championships. Additionally, all competitors who use the Non-Member pass must provide a signed USA Climbing waiver at each event.

Non-Member Pass: \$5.00 per event

Competitors who use the Non-Member Pass have until 11:59 pm mountain time on the Tuesday after the competition (ABS or SCS) in which to become members of that series (ABS or SCS) and receive attendance credit and ranking for that competition. USA CLIMBING PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

Please complete and return this form along with your completed registration form and payment. USA Climbing MUST have a completed form ON FILE for you before you can compete. This form, which includes an acknowledgement and assumption of risks, and agreements of release and indemnity, is required annually of all members. It pertains to all events and other relationships with USA Climbing, ABS (American Bouldering Series), SCS (Sport Climbing Series), Pro-Series, and USAC Exhibitions during the 2009-2010 season; and must be signed by all participants, adult or minor (under 18 years of age), and the parent or guardian of a minor participant. The parent or guardian signs for himself or herself and on behalf of the minor participant.

For and in consideration of the services of USA Climbing, the undersigned Participant (adult or minor) and the parent or guardian of a minor participant (referred to below as "I" unless otherwise indicated), acknowledges and agrees as follows: the activities and competitions in which Participant will participate include climbing and competing on artificial surfaces. Such activities include, but not exclusively, the following risks: falling off the wall; loose and/or damaged artificial holds; equipment failure; falling to the ground, onto other individuals or objects, or being fallen upon by other participants; abrasions from the walls, ropes, holds, or the floor; belay failure; climbing beyond ones personal limits; the negligence of other climbers, belayers, spectators, or other persons present; muscular-skeletal injuries and strains, inaccurate or poorly informed judging; inappropriate application of rules or standards; or participant negligence.

These and other risks not described could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or other damage to participants, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks cannot be eliminated without diminishing the essential qualities of the activities. Furthermore, I acknowledge that USA Climbing staff, officials, officers, and volunteers have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety and fairness, but they are not infallible. The complex nature of competition and competition training contains elements of uncertainty which dictates that all possible contingencies can not be anticipated.

Participant, and parent or guardian of minor participant expressly accept and assume all risks associated with enrollment or participation in the activities and competitions of USA Climbing, whether or not described above, and inherent or otherwise.

I, if I am an adult Participant or parent or guardian of a minor participant, further agree as follows:

a) I assume all financial responsibility for any injury or damage incurred by Participant while participating in USA Climbing activities and competitions. I further agree, on behalf of myself, the minor for whom I sign, members of my family, heirs, assigns, personal representatives and my estate, to release, discharge, indemnify and hold harmless USA Climbing, its owners, agents, employees, officers, directors and sponsors from any and all claims, by whomever they may be brought, and including claims of negligence, which are in any way connected with my or the minor's enrollment or participation in USA Climbing activities.

b) I acknowledge that this agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive laws of the state of Colorado. Any suit or action filed by any party to enforce this agreement or otherwise with respect to the subject matter of this agreement, shall be filed in the state of Colorado. If any provision of this agreement is found by a court of law to be invalid or unenforceable in any respect for any reason, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provision of this agreement shall not be affected.

c) I agree that I, or the minor for whom I sign, will abide by all the rules and ruling so USA Climbing. I agree that USA Climbing has the authority to restrict and/or remove the participant from any participation USA Climbing activity or competition for any reason.
